Creating an aquaculture value chain





In the early 1980's Gregory Stubbs (CEO at Three Streams Holdings), recognised the need to remove pressure on the ocean's dwindling resources and believed that aquaculture would be the only solution to meet future seafood demand. He began farming trout on the family farm as an undergraduate student at Stellenbosch University, before going on to complete an MSc in aquaculture at Sterling University in Scotland.

Greg recognised the importance of developing a market for aquaculture products was essential in building an industry and, today, the company is involved in the entire value chain,

including R&D in the farming of marine fin-fish.
