Mustard - why it should no longer be the food industry's best kept secret

Anthony is currently MD of Dunmustard, and previously held positions as Director of Blue Sky Mustard, Mustard Millers as well as Besco Grain Ltd, Canada. Blue Sky Mustard Ltd is a trading house buying both seed from Besco Grain and flours from various dry millers for resale in 63 countries around the world. Besco Grain Ltd, in Manitoba Canada supplies pedigree mustard seed to contracted growers in Canada. In turn growers supply contracted crops to Besco Grain, who process, clean and grade mustard seed before supplying dry mustard millers in Canada and the USA and wet millers throughout the world. Besco Grain Ltd is a member of the Canadian Mustard Association and Mustard 21 which are at the forefront of mustard research and development.

Dunmustard buys milled mustard flours from dry millers such as GS Dunn for supply to the food industry in South Africa.
